## Philharmonic Offers Workshops in March

The first Fort Wayne Philharmonic International Conductors' and Concertmasters' Workshop will be held March 10-13 in association with Indiana University-Purdue University Fort Wayne and supported by the 80/20 Foundation. Philharmonic Music Director Andrew Constantine, Professor Ennio Nicotra of Milano-Bicocca University, and concertmaster Jonathan Carney of the Baltimore Symphony Orchestra will lead young aspiring conductors and concertmasters in an intense series of workshops, discussions and a closing public concert with the Fort Wayne Philharmonic.

The workshops will include extensive sessions with orchestra, two pianos and individual lessons. For conductors, the focus will be on the techniques of the most celebrated conducting teacher of the 20th century, Ilya Musin. Concertmaster classes will include the Art of Bowing and Audition and Concerto Preparation.
